Alberta budget tightens belt, but finds room for transit

From a provincial budget perspective, times are tough in Alberta right now thanks to low oil prices. That said, the recently released Alberta budget, titled "Supporting Jobs, Supporting Families," still managed to find room to support the government's Transit promises. The government dedicated \$330 million by 2020 in new funding for transit initiatives, in addition to the \$946 million already committed through the GreenTRIP fund over five years.
