Dear Minister,

I am writing to introduce myself as the new President and Chief Executive Officer of the [Canadian Urban Transit Association](#) (CUTA), and request that our organization be consulted by your department in its ongoing efforts to find a solution to the issue of rural inter-city bus services in Western Canada.

As you are already aware, CUTA is the collective and influential voice of public transportation in Canada. Our membership includes the vast majority of Canadian transit systems, private transport operators and transit thought-leaders from coast to coast. CUTA is uniquely positioned to work with the federal government to provide expert industry insight on key transport policy issues with a single, unified voice.

Rural inter-city bus services connect Canadians across the country to each other and to basic social services, like healthcare and education. I trust that my organization's expertise in public transport and our collective industry voice would add value to Transport Canada's consultations to find an effective solution to this issue.
