This position supervises and provides leadership and guidance to City staff, contractors and consultants, analyzing the effectiveness and economic impact of Transit and Transportation programs and all processes and procedures. The Supervisor is responsible for delivering effective service to internal and external clients and users of transit in Fort Saskatchewan. This includes providing excellent customer service, marketing, public relations to user groups, residents and public, and promoting the service at local events through media/advertising.

The successful candidate will have a minimum of a Diploma from a recognized Institution or University with course work in Project Management, Transportation Planning, Land Use Planning, Transit Planning, Transit Network Planning Transit Planning, Transit Network Planning or Business Administration. A Degree is preferred. A minimum of five years' experience in transit development, operations, transportation planning, communications, business development or project management is required.
