ABOUT THE ROLE

Reporting to the Director of Engineering and Transportation, the Senior Manager, Transit will be responsible for the efficient, reliable and safe operation of public transit. Using innovative leadership and proactive management skills, the successful candidate will collaborate with District leadership and stakeholders, and work effectively within TransLink's organizational requirements, to serve the community.

Primary duties of this role include: maintaining a safe and efficient operation of the transit system; ensuring the distinct character of the Blue Bus system is maintained; negotiating and implementing the Operating Agreement with TransLink; leading the Department's management team; and maintaining effective working relationships with all levels of staff, the public and community, and government agencies.

The ideal candidate will have a bachelor's degree in Engineering or Business Administration with an extensive background in a public transit environment, and management experience. An equivalent combination of education and transit experience will be considered. A vehicle and a valid BC Driver's License is required, ideally with endorsements to operate a bus that is "Not in Service". The successful candidate is required to supply a police information check (vulnerable sector) and a copy of their credentials. All District of West Vancouver employees are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 as a condition of hire.
