Our Rail Fleet Maintenance Office is looking for a Senior Manager to provide oversight on cost effective, safe, reliable, and clean Rail Equipment and meet the requirements of the Operating Timetable.

What will I be doing?

- Manages GO Transit's Rail Equipment fleet to meet customer needs in accordance with corporate business plans; manages ongoing major refurbishment and capital improvement programs for locomotives, coaches, cab cars, and facilities.
- Responds to emergencies involving GO Transit rail equipment and facilities, and investigates and reports pertinent facts.
- Negotiates contracts with railways and vendors for supplementary maintenance and/or rebuild of equipment, components, and facilities.
- Works with senior and middle management of maintenance contractors to direct work priorities and schedules, advise of liquidated damages, manage invoice discrepancies, operational changes, or conflicts, and exchange information.
- Develops and practices management control systems to maximize safety, environmental sensitivity, and expense accountability.
- Establishes operating and capital budgets for rail equipment maintenance, capital improvements, and refurbishment.
- Provides creative thought leadership with input from others to develop and deploy a strategic vision; connects and aligns projects.
- Provides senior leadership oversight and direction to staff and project teams; delivers timely feedback to ensure a cohesive operational unit and the optimum use of team skills; manages staff and monitors work assignments to ensure adherence to timelines.

What skills & qualifications do I need?

- Completion of a degree in Electrical / Mechanical Engineering, or a related discipline, or a combination of education, training and experience deemed equivalent.
- Minimum ten (10) years' progressive experience in railway/transit equipment maintenance, including experience in plant facility maintenance and supervision.
- Knowledge of work planning and other industrial engineering techniques is required
- Knowledge of rules and regulations established by Transport Canada (TC), Federal Railway Administration (FRA), American Association of Railways (AAR), American Passenger Transportation Association (APTA) standards, building codes, and environmental legislation

- Knowledge of procurement processes, and vendor and contract management, negotiation, and influencing skills to negotiate and administer Managerial expertise to provide senior technical and administrative leadership to an operating or functional unit with multiple teams
- Personal resiliency to manage conflicting pressures and address front-line customer-facing issues
- Interpersonal and oral/written/presentation skills.
