Senior Manager, Construction – AMENDMENT

As the Senior Manager, Construction you will be responsible for leading a team to manage various components of the Green Line. You will report to the Construction Director of Green Line and will work closely with Commercial, Technical, Project Controls, Stakeholder Relations and Business Services team members to successfully deliver the Stage 1 program which is 20 km in length with a capital cost of \$4.9 B. Stage 1 includes at-grade, elevated, and underground urban LRT track, stations, in addition to several bridges and three river crossings. Primary duties of the Senior Manager, Construction include but not limited to:

- Assist the project team to ensure the project objectives, budget, schedule, and performance standards are achieved in compliance with Green Line policies, procedures, standards, and specifications.
- Supervise staff and provide support to ensure roles and responsibilities are clear and goals and objectives are achieved.
- Review technical documents and ensure compliance with corporate safety, project management standards, procedures, controls, and environmental requirements.
- Ensure effective management of communication between the contractor and other internal and external stakeholders, including utility companies and authorities having jurisdiction.
- Assist with the development of the project risk register, mitigation measures, and facilitate effective conflict resolution.
- Work with the project team to ensure all project deliverables are understood and scheduled to comply with construction contract needs, including utilities, environmental, and third-party agreements.
- Coordinate the integration of Green Line support functions including Commercial, Technical, Legal, Project Controls, Communication and Business Services into the successful delivery of the project.
- Provide subject matter expertise in constructability and value management/engineering reviews for projects and act as a construction expert in claims scenarios.
- Manage complex project issues and risks and facilitate effective conflict resolution.
- Monitor all aspects of Green Line delivery, including financial accountability, contract and schedule management, contractor adherence to reference designs and performance specifications, and support for program communications during all stages of the project.
- Perform constructability reviews for the project with support from the Technical team.
- Any other duties as assigned by the Construction Director.

Qualifications

- A degree in Engineering or a related field.
- At least 10 years of experience in large and complex infrastructure projects, including experience in projects involving utility relocation, deep excavation, underground work, bridges and/or tunneling.
- Design Build (Finance) or other Public Private Partnership (P3) experience would be an asset.
- Demonstrated project management experience leading a multidisciplinary team in large-scale construction projects.
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment, with competing priorities.
- Demonstrated ability to coordinate and communicate proactively and respectfully across various Green Line functions.
- Excellent analytical, organizational, negotiation skills and strong leadership abilities.
