Position Overview

The Sunshine Coast Regional District is currently inviting applications for the position of Transportation Superintendent (Full-Time, Exempt). Under the general direction of the Manager, Transit & Fleet, the Transportation Superintendent manages the day to day operation of the transit system including on-time performance, customer service, hiring, training new drivers in the delivery of transit service, and ensuring safe operations based on the Motor Vehicle Act and other applicable legislation and regulations.

Compensation and Hours of Work

This full-time exempt position working 35-hours per week and includes an annual salary ranging from **\$91,480** up to a merit maximum of **\$116,180**. This position includes vacation that starts at 4 weeks and up to 12 days of compensatory leave in lieu of overtime. Vacation porting is available to those who come from specific public service areas. You will receive a full benefit package upon hire that includes extended health and dental coverage, a combined paramedical package of up to \$1250/year, eyewear, eye exams, paid sick leave, family responsibility leave, short-term and long-term disability leave, group life insurance, accidental death and dismemberment coverage, and participation in the Municipal Pension Plan (MPP). And finally, all SCRD employees have access to the Employee and Family Assistance Program (EFAP) upon hire, for free, confidential counselling services.

Please note: The SCRD transit system is a 7-day a week operation, this position may be required to work weekends, late evening and early morning shifts.
