- Supervise the overall repair and daily servicing of the bus fleet ensuring they meet service requirements
- Provide technical guidance and/or assistance to support quality assurance of repair work
- Will assist the Manager, Maintenance in the overall operation of the garage through analysis of technical problems, planning and scheduling of work and maintenance of technical information
- Ensure all paperwork (e.g. repair orders and labour entries) are completed and processed in a timely manner
- Participate in labour relations issues including bargaining committee during negotiations and represent the Commission in grievance and arbitration hearings
- Ensure compliance with all applicable environmental and safety rules and regulations
- Liaise with the Parts & Inventory Manager regarding procurement of repair parts and materials
