Our Planning & Development office is seeking a Senior Planning Officer to conduct comprehensive strategic and technical transportation planning & analysis to develop plans for new transportation services and associated fleet, infrastructure and operational requirements, and optimize existing services in support of corporate business, market, service, and long-range planning objectives. This role will primarily lead planning studies and business cases to support the transition to zero-emissions bus technologies and related infrastructure.

What will I be doing?

- Leading business case development for future service strategic plans, fleet and service-related infrastructure investments including zero-emissions bus technologies and related infrastructure.
- Project management of multi-disciplinary service planning and zero-emissions mobility projects, externally mandated projects, and other corporate programs.
- Providing comprehensive strategic and transit planning/analysis to develop plans for new, coordinated and optimized of services, in support of the Metrolinx's long-range planning objectives.
- Overseeing consultant assignments, negotiating fees, cost sharing agreements, approvals and contractual claims.
- Acting as a key point of contact and facilitator, liaising with stakeholders, municipal partners and provincial ministries on GO Transit service planning matters.
- Works with counterparts and senior management of other Metrolinx departments, transit agencies, provincial ministries, municipalities, private companies such as consultants and contractors and the public to facilitate the advancement and implementation of service and capital projects
- Represents Metrolinx at external agency meetings for transit service plans, business cases, transportation master plans, environmental assessments or other planning studies
- Supervises staff engaged in all stages of project management to develop and execute long-range and short-term bus and rail service planning and infrastructure plans

What Skills and Qualifications Do I Need?

 Thorough knowledge of innovative and progressive transit planning processes and methodologies, including knowledge of government transportation direction, transportation policy analysis, and transportation data analysis and modeling.

- Demonstrated Project Management skills, with the ability to co-ordinate different complex projects under pressure, meeting schedule and budget commitments.
- Knowledge and practical experience with zero-emissions transit fleet/infrastructure projects would be considered a strong asset.
- Knowledge and sensitivity to the needs of transit operators including operations, funding and governance.
- Excellent analytical ability, oral/written communication competencies, and facilitation skills.
- Interpersonal and oral/written communication skills to edit and review consultant reports, design drawings, specifications, and contract documents, and to develop and deliver presentations to senior management and other stakeholders.
- Knowledge of the theories, principles and practices of transportation planning procedures, engineering and/or planning, specification writing, construction, contract and office administration,
- Project management and supervisory principles and practices to supervise project staff and coordinate multiple complex projects under pressure to meet schedule and budget commitments
- Analytical and negotiation skills and political acuity to present the corporate position in conditions that are frequently adversarial
- High level of mental concentration required for comprehensive proofreading, editing and design review of consultant reports, design drawings, specifications, and contract documents
- When visiting external sites, may be required to traverse rail corridors, undeveloped sites, construction sites or rough terrain and may be exposed to inclement weather
